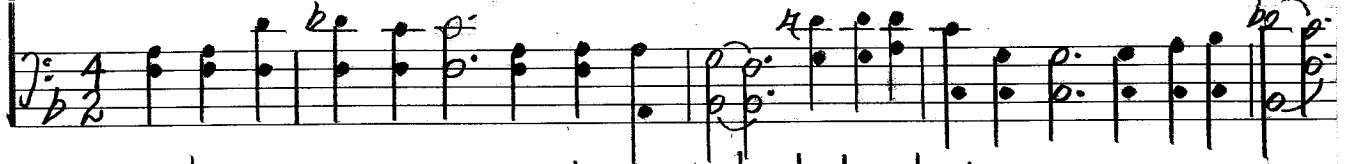

2. As light com - plete - ly fades, in - vok - ing night, Then mid - night black in - vades one's earth - ly sight,



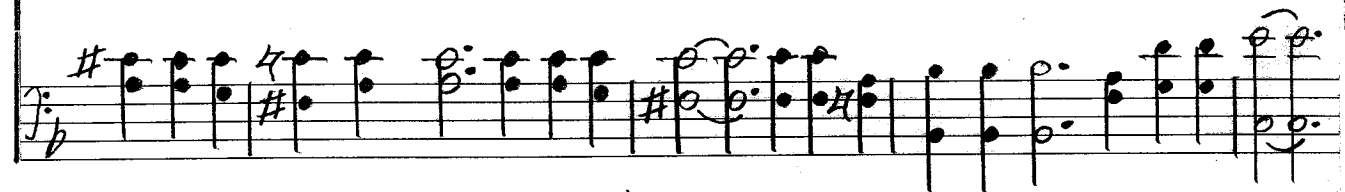
Make pil - grim feel the chill of cer - tain night And sense the loss of will in dim - ming light.
