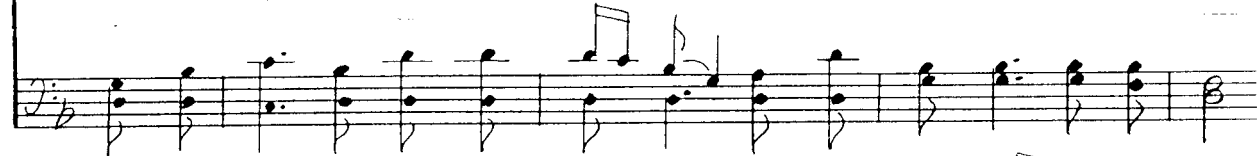

2. For the soul who lives in dark - ness And a - lone must face the night,



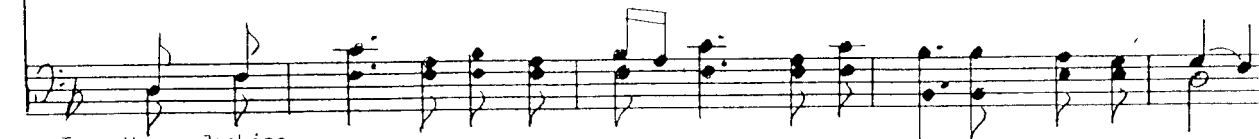
Or when pain holds forth till day - light And the crip - pler rais - es fears;
