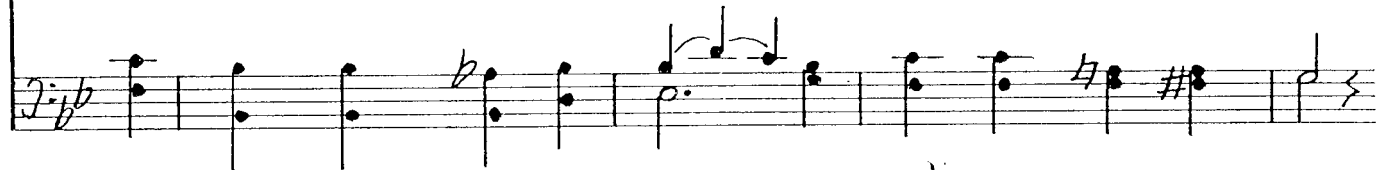

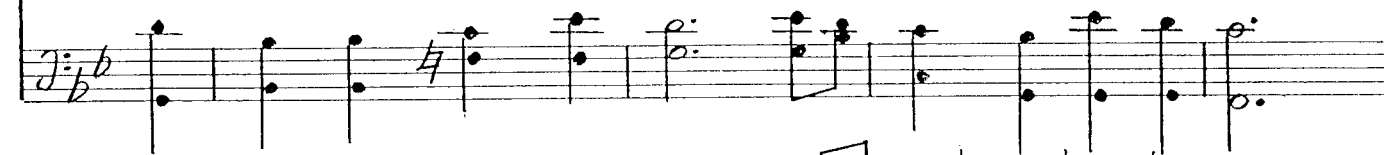
1. As keep - er of the earth, So charged in A - dam's day,
