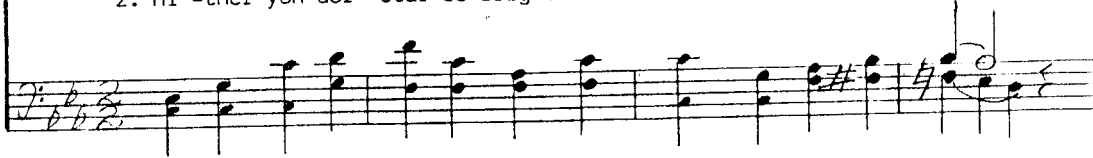


WHITHER YONDER STAR
