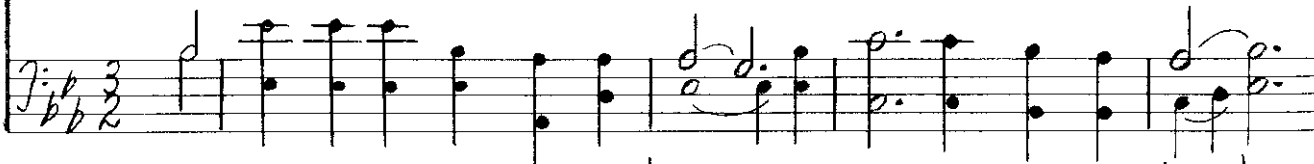

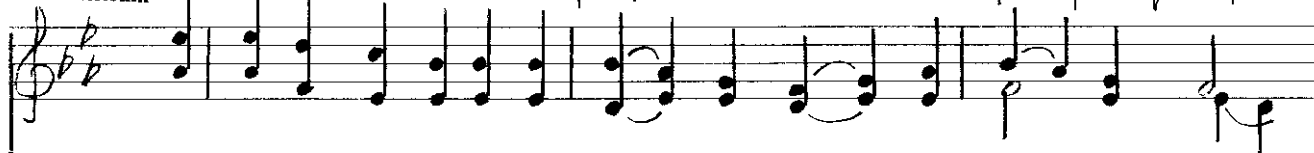
1. How love - ly is your dwel - ling place, O Lord, Al - might - ty God,

3. The spar - row found from you a home, The swal - low, for her young,



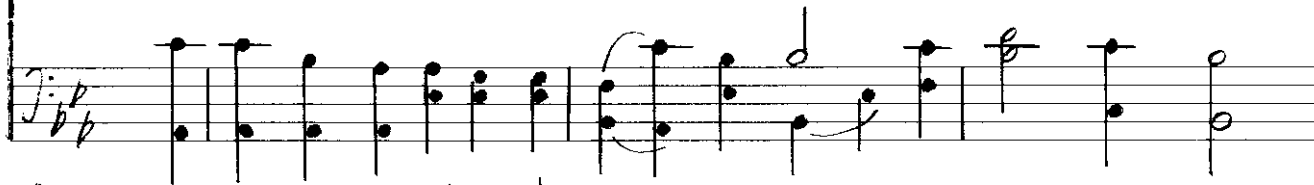
My soul yearns, e - ven faints to pace The courts where you have trod.
